Megan Creecy-Herman serves as Vice President, Leasing & Development for Liberty Property Trust's Arizona region.

Liberty Property Trust is the nation's largest publicly-traded industrial and office REIT (by market capitalization) NYSE: LPT with over 105 million square feet of office and industrial properties throughout the U.S. and U.K.

Ms. Creecy-Herman has been in commercial real estate in the Phoenix market since 2002 and joined Liberty Property Trust in 2012. In her current role, Ms. Creecy-Herman is responsible for portfolio leasing, development and acquisition activities in Arizona. The company owns a total of 4 million square feet of office and industrial space in Scottsdale, Phoenix, Tempe and Tolleson. Liberty also controls a total of 300 acres of developable land in Goodyear, Scottsdale, Tempe and Phoenix. Notable current development projects over which Ms. Creecy-Herman has oversight include the 1 million square foot Liberty Center at Rio Salado mixed-use business park in Tempe and the 1.5 million square foot Liberty Logistics Center II industrial park in Phoenix. Prior to joining Liberty Property Trust, Ms. Creecy-Herman was with EJM Development Co. one of the largest private developers of industrial properties in the Southwestern United States.

In 2014 Ms. Creecy-Herman served as the first female Chairman of the NAIOP (the Commercial Real Estate Development Association) Arizona Board of Directors, also becoming the youngest Chairman

in the nation to lead a large Chapter. For her work as Chairman in 2014 she received the prestigious NAIOP National Chairman of the Year award. In 2015 she joined the NAIOP National Executive Committee and National Board of Directors.

In 2009 she was a recipient of the NAIOP National Developing Leaders Award and also in 2009 she received the inaugural NAIOP Arizona Chapter Developing Leaders Award, for being the person age 35 and under who made the most significant contribution to NAIOP and the Arizona real estate community.

Ms. Creecy-Herman is an active member of the Urban Land Institute, Valley Partnership, the National Association of Foreign Trade Zones, the Arizona State University Real Estate Alumni Club and the Junior League of Phoenix. She also holds the designation of LEED Green Associate with the USGBC.

She is a graduate of Arizona State University with a B.S. in 2003 and an M.B.A. (master of business administration) from the University of Arizona in 2012.
