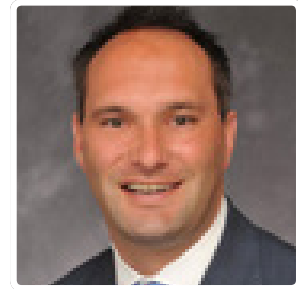


# Mitchell L. Stravitz
